



Wimbledon Ticket Allocation

The improper use of Wimbledon tickets will result in Cambourne Lawn Tennis Club (CLTC) losing their ticket allocation in future years so the following must be **strictly adhered to** if you are successful in the Wimbledon ticket draw.

1. The tickets are issued by the LTA to the CLTC member and are therefore **STRICTLY NON TRANSFERABLE.**
2. If it is found that tickets have been sold to a third party, such as via an internet auction site or friends and family, CLTC reserve the right to expel the club member.

Note: Internet auction sites are closely monitored by the LTA

3. If you are successful in the draw you will be contacted by letter with details of the ticket allocation. Payment for the tickets will need to be made within 7 days if you wish to use the tickets. Upon receipt of payment, the LTA will be notified by CLTC of the member's name to allocate to the ticket.
4. During the draw, 3 members will be selected for each ticket. If you are successful in the draw but unable to use your allocated tickets, please contact Dean Harper (as above) so the tickets can be offered to the next person in the draw.
5. Wimbledon tickets are **only made available to CLTC one week before the actual event.** If you were successful in the draw and have made a payment for your tickets, a committee member will arrange to meet with you at a mutually convenient time and handover the tickets. At this point you will also be required to sign a form which is issued by the LTA.
